

Puppy Raising Agreement Form

1. Puppy must live in house and sleep in Puppy Raiser's bedroom.
2. Puppy must be housebroken, instructed in in-house etiquette and socialized with strange dogs (dogs not part of the program or household).
3. Puppy Raiser is required to attend regularly held puppy-training classes provided by the program, agree to reinforce training at home and fill out weekly progress reports.
4. Puppy must be fed the diet provided by the program and follow all guidelines.
5. Puppy will accompany Puppy Raiser whenever and wherever possible and should be taken to public places regularly to experience crowds, traffic, confusing and loud noises (trains, trucks, children at play, music, etc.) and other unusual environments.
6. Puppy should wear approved cape, ID, collar and leash when taken on all outings.
7. Puppy shall live with foster family until approximately 20-24 months of age.
8. Puppy Raiser must agree to treat the house and environment for fleas and ticks, if their house is infected.
9. Puppy Raiser must at all times love and respect the puppy and agree to report any behavior/command problems to the program director. No physical punishment will be allowed.
10. Visits to the Puppy Raiser's residence by a program representative may occur periodically with reasonable advance notification.
11. Puppy Raiser agrees to return the puppy upon request of the program.
12. Whenever the Puppy Raiser goes on vacation, the puppy must be placed with an approved Puppy Sitter and the program director notified.
13. Puppy Raiser's age requirement will be determined by the program director. Parental consent is required if Puppy Raiser is under 18 years of age.
14. Puppy shall not be left unattended near a swimming pool or any other hazardous area.
15. Puppy Raiser agrees to follow program protocol in regards to all health related care and veterinary treatment (see Canine Injury/Accident Report).
