Frequently Asked Questions

When & Where: We offer 1 week of camp during spring break from March 18th through March 22nd, 2019. Four Summer Camps will be offered-- Session 1: June 10th to June 14th, Session 2: June 17th to 21st, Session 3: July 8th to 12th, Session 4: July 15th to 19th. Each camp takes place Monday through Friday from 9 am to 3 pm.

The cost to attend the program is \$200.00 per child/per week.

What: Campers spend their day with our program dogs learning and participating in:

1. Basic Dog Training – obedience and service dog cues.
2. Dog Grooming, pet first aid, daily care and dog maintenance.
3. Dog related games, arts and crafts.
4. Special presentations related to animal welfare.

Each day your child will be training and caring for a dog that has been assigned to them.

Who: Camp is open to children between the ages of 9 and 14.

Some general information about our camp:

- Each child is to bring their own bag lunch. We provide an afternoon snack and beverage. Please alert staff to any food allergies your child may have.
- Please ensure that campers arrive on time, camp begins at 9:00 am and ends at 3:00 pm. A late fee of \$25 for every 30 minutes will be charged per camper for pick-ups after 3:15 pm. If you are going to be late, please call the office, (813) 558-5406 to let us know.
- Pick up and drop off will be at the Kids & Canines facility on Dorothy Thomas Campus. You can find the facility off 3215 Nundy Rd, past the school's main office. It will be marked your first day to help guide you.
- All individuals picking up children at the end of the day MUST be authorized on your registration form. ID is required for student pick up.

- Your child will be working with several breeds of dogs such as golden retrievers, border collies, labs, poodles and shepherd mixes. All of these dogs have been working with teens in our training program.
- Payment is required to confirm your registration. This can be made online. **The camp is limited to 15 campers and is filled on a first come – first served basis.**
- All forms (liability waiver, media release and registration) and your payment need to be returned to Kids and Canines to guarantee a place for your child. Camp fees are non-refundable 30 days prior to the first day of camp.
- Dress is casual. Remember your child will be indoors and outdoors with their dog when training, and may be getting messy!
- Each camper will be given a Kids & Canines camp tee shirt. Please inform us of your child's size on the registration form. We ask that every child wear their shirts on Tuesday for the camp photos.
